Senior Prom Policy 2017 - 2018

- Must be eligible to graduate
 - 22+ credits (Sept)
 - passing all required courses on mid-year report, or receive a school leaving certificate
 - Eligibility list available: April
 - NOTE: All students have the right to appeal
- Must not miss 10+ days unexcused absences or have suspensions per term (Sept.-Feb.).

- Students must be at Waterford Valley High before 1 a.m. to be permitted entrance to Safe Grad.

Cost

- Prom tickets: \$115???? for the Grad's ticket (Prom, Yearbook and the Safe Grad ticket is still unknown), \$75 for each additional ticket.
- Covers the cost of the meal, security, decorations, programs, printing of tickets, sound system, DJ and other miscellaneous fees.
- Tickets go on sale Wednesday, May 1, 2018 from 3:30 – 5:00 pm at the School's main office.

Seating Plan

- When buying tickets sign the booklet at the main office with floor plan of the Convention Centre.
- Sign your child's name at a table for each ticket that you purchase, (for example if you buy 4 tickets please sign the student's name four times)
- Write your table number on your ticket to make sure you know the table at which you will sit during the Ceremony.

Seating Plan (cont'd)

- Individual seating arrangements will not be finalized until all fees are paid.
- Seating chart will be posted at the Convention Centre
- Remember to write your table number on your ticket when you purchase your tickets.
- Foyer will be crowded; people must find their seats quickly when students line up for Grand March.
- No changes in seating will be possible after seating chart has been finalized.
